Spirit Rock Reservation

The Spirit Rock, which stands at the entrance to Poplin Elementary School, is available for painting Happy Birthday messages as well as messages of congratulations or well-wishes.

All money raised from the use of the Spirit Rock will go towards supporting the various PTA programs at Poplin Elementary.

Spirit Rock Rules:

- 1. You may paint the rock anytime on/after 5pm the night BEFORE your reservation day/date.
- 2. The rock can be painted by only one family per day.
- 3. If you can't paint the rock on your reserved day (inclement weather, conflict in your schedule, just forgot, etc.), you are not allowed to choose another day.
- 4. The family painting the rock assumes liability for any individual or member of the group/organization who may be injured or who incur clothing or other personal property damage.
- 5. Families must furnish their own labor, paint and supplies to paint the rock.
- 6. ONLY the rock can be painted. Painting on sidewalks, lampposts, grass, or buildings is prohibited. Any damage or destruction to the surrounding areas or buildings will deem the family financially responsible for cleaning and repair costs.
- 7. What is painted on the spirit rock must be in good taste and may not contain any foul language, discriminatory or political remarks. Profanity and obscenities are not permitted. What is painted must be in accordance to your Poplin's student code of conduct.

Please Note:

You may paint the rock anytime on/after 5pm the night BEFORE your reservation day/date. (i.e. If your child's birthday is on August 30th and you reserve the 30th, you can paint on/after 5pm on August 29th and the message will remain up until 5pm on August 30th).

Tips:

The best paint to use is spray paint. You will probably need 2-3 cans for a good base coat. It will depend upon the color you are using, the color already painted on the rock and weather conditions. Remember, latex paint or paint that is rolled on will take longer to dry.
